

UNIT 4 – SMOKE ALARMS

Smoke Alarms

When you are asleep you lose your sense of smell. A smoke alarm is your electronic nose! It will alert you if there is smoke from a fire. You will have time to escape.



You must have at least one smoke alarm on every level of your home. It is the law!

Smoke alarms should be installed on the ceiling at least 30 centimetres from the walls. They should be in all living areas, hallways and bedrooms,

Your smoke alarm is only good if it is working! Test it every month to make sure the battery is not flat. Push the button and wait for the 'beep, beep'.

If you have a smoke alarm with a 9-volt battery, replace the battery every year. Dust around the outside cover of your smoke alarm at least once a year.

All smoke alarms need to be replaced every ten years. Install smoke alarms with a 10 year long-life battery.

Only working smoke alarms save lives!

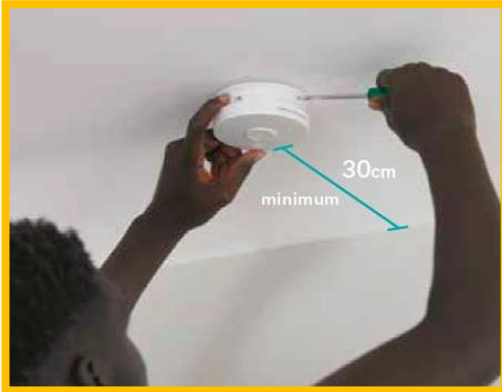

Only Working Smoke Alarms Save Lives

The emergency call taker asked her which emergency service she required. He then asked her for the address of the unit.

The fire trucks were on the way very quickly.



The firefighters arrived in the street 4 minutes later. The neighbour was waiting outside. She waved them down.

There was a lot of smoke coming from a window of the unit. The neighbour was unsure if anyone was inside.

The firefighters rushed inside to search the smoky unit.

They found two young men asleep on chairs in the lounge room. The smoke alarm in the unit was not working. The firefighters woke the two men and helped them outside to the fresh air. They were both coughing and covering their eyes. There was lots of smoke.

One of the men, Matthew, had left food cooking in a pot on the kitchen stove and had fallen asleep. The food had got too hot and started to burn.

The two men would have woken and escaped earlier if the unit had a working smoke alarm. They were lucky their neighbour had phoned 000 (Triple Zero) quickly.

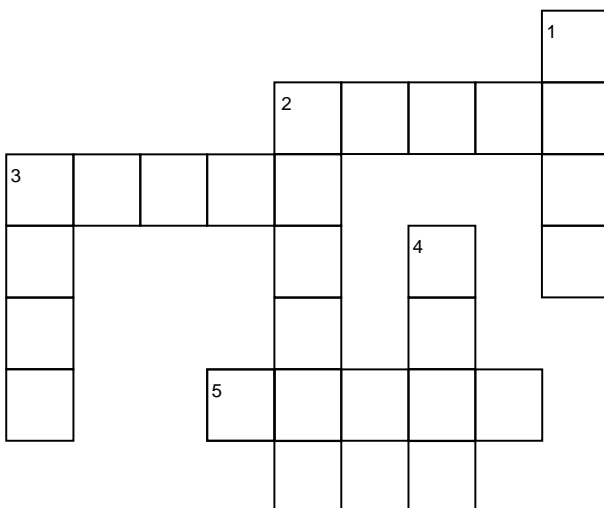
